The authors from Turkey each write under a pseudonym: «Under today's conditions, they cannot dare to openly express criticism of the constitutional situation under their own name: This fact alone is an important statement in the context of the topic under discussion.»

The articles are aimed at lawyers and politicians, but also at all other readers throughout Europe – including Turkey – and overseas who are interested in the rule of law, democracy based on the separation of powers and an independent judiciary.

The book is multilingual: the contributions are written in English, German or French; they contain a short summary in English, French, German and Turkish.
